## Greek Week 2012 Rules

2. Every chapter must have their chapter entry fee turned in no later than, February 9<sup>th</sup>, 2012.
3. If a chapter decides to drop out of Greek Week, they will forfeit their entry fee.
4. There will be NO alcohol, drugs, or other controlled substances at any Greek Week related events (including practices, meetings, etc.). Violations of this rule will result in immediate disqualification from the event or week as determined by the Greek Life Staff.

6. Although we encourage ideas and input, all decisions made by the Greek Week Staff are final.
7. Any deadline not met will result in loss of points and/or fine.
8. Please remember that you are the liaison between the Greek Week Staff and your chapter/team. Please relay all information in a **timely** and **accurate** manner.
9. The Greek Life Office reserves the right to make changes and qualifying decisions at any point prior to, during, and post Greek Week.

**“Greeks Give”: Scholarship and Leadership Fundraiser**

**Purpose:** To raise funds for the UNT Greek Scholarship, presented annually to two Greek members (one male, one female)

**Ticket Information:**

- \$5 per ticket
- Each member is responsible for selling 5 tickets (raising \$25 per person)

**What to do:** Keep ticket stub with buyer’s contact information. Have buyer keep the larger half.

**Prize Drawings:** Drawings will be held at Eagle Escapades on Friday, March 9<sup>th</sup>. One \$1000 cash prize and two \$500 cash prizes will be given away. (Greek students have won all drawings for each of the last five years.) There will also be more drawings for other prizes such as gift cards, etc.

**DUE: Tuesday, February 21<sup>st</sup> 2012 (Money, ticket stubs, and unsold tickets are all due)**

**IMPORTANCE:** The scholarship fundraiser is one of two activities worth the most points during Greek Week. This is our opportunity as a community to contribute to the University of North Texas Scholarship Fund in a substantial way. The Greek Community is the only student group to donate at such a level financially to the university. We have donated a minimum of \$10,000 each of the last seven years. Our goal is to endow the Greek Community Scholarship, so funds will always be available as a financial support to our members.

Money raised will also go to Greek Leadership Support. This way the money raised will be going straight back to our community through programs, office initiatives, and leadership conferences!

**JUDGING:**

You must have 1-2 members (no more than 2) present to explain your banner and point out any details you would like the judges to take notice of. You will be judged on the presentation as well! 3. Faculty/staff member **MUST** bring their invitation in order for the team to get credit (please fill out the team portion for them)

**Program attendance:**

Teams must have 5 members present at all times at the event to mix and mingle with the faculty/staff. Food will be provided for only faculty/staff members and each of the team's 5 members present.

Every Greek member will receive 2 invitations for UNT faculty and staff. More invitations may be found in the Greek Life Office. For every faculty or staff member that shows up, teams will receive 10 points. Faculty/Staff must bring their invitation to track points. One faculty/staff member may bring more than one invitation; each team will receive the full allotted points.

**Faculty/Staff member MUST attend the event in order for points to be awarded.**

- A detailed order of songs and track numbers, lighting, sound effects, or other technical requirements should be prepared and given to the sound technician.
- The Greek Week Committee reserves the right to request changes. Therefore, please be certain there is nothing inappropriate (e.g., for costuming, dance moves, profane lyrics, etc.) in your routine. The Greek Week Committee will make all final decisions regarding appropriateness.
- No objects, glitter, confetti, or anything that requires clean up is allowed during rehearsal or Friday's performance.
- No changes may be made to the routine between rehearsal and Friday's performance, unless requested by the Greek Week Committee. **Changes may result in disqualification.** Special circumstances should be addressed to the Greek Advisor who will consult with the committee for final approval.

## UNT CANstruction

### Friday, March 9, 2011 10am-2pm – Library Mall

We are excited to announce, that **Greek Week 2012** is participating in the Third Annual CANstruction Competition on Friday, March 9, 2012 from 10am-2pm at the Library Mall.

Below is some information to help your team prepare for CANstruction:

- Get creative, have fun and build the best sculptures out of non-perishable food.
- Sculptures are judged on size and creativity!
- All food benefits the Denton Community Food Center.

**In the first two years of CANstruction, more than 17,000 pounds of food was collected for the Denton Community.**

**This sounds like a large amount of food... But each year, the Denton Community Food Center distributes 400,000 pounds of food to the local community!**



## CANstruction Basic Guidelines

- ◆ Only non-perishable food may be used. Any size food (big or small) can be used in the structure.
- ◆ Make sure that you have collected cans for your structure **IN ADVANCE** of CANstruction Day. Cans are **NOT** provided for CANstruction—**you must bring your own.**
- ◆ The judges will use discretion. Sculptures with more cans will be weighted more than sculptures with less cans (i.e. cans are weighted heavier than ramen noodles)
- ◆ The structure must be self-supporting. (Not taped to the wall)
- ◆ Props may be used to add to the creativity of the sculpture. In fact, they are **encouraged!**
- ◆ The cans/boxes cannot be harmed and their labels must remain intact. Cans cannot be painted
- ◆ The structure must be built in an **8'x 10'** area.
- ◆ The teams will have from 10am-2pm to construct their sculpture at the Library Mall (rain site is inside the Union)

# Judging for CANstruction!

The top structures that receive the most votes and fit the guidelines will receive great awards. Sculptures will be judged as follows:

- ◆ Size of the sculptures. Teams will submit a form with a count of the food items in their sculpture. This count is subject to verification by the judges.
- ◆ Creativity of the sculpture. Judges will be looking for creativity and how the sculpture represents UNT and addresses hunger.
- ◆ Judges will announce the Grand Prize winner at 4pm on Friday, March 9, 2011. Winners will be awarded trophies.
- ◆ There will be bonus points for teams wearing Green and showing Green Pride.
