Statement of Necessity

A Greek Ambassador program is necessary to more adequately promote the true purpose of fraternity and sorority life.

PURPOSE

2. Seek change in negative perspectives of the Greek community.
3. Impact the outlook of the faculty, staff, and students in regards to Greek Life.
4. Further connect Greek organizations to the University and Denton communities.
5. Promote and increase Greek membership.

DUTIES

- Host Greek Housing tours and informational sessions for students at orientation and through the semester.
- Outreach and present programs to various groups across Denton and the campus community about going Greek.
 - Attend organization meetings and educate student leaders on UNT's fraternities and sororities
- Facilitate various programs for Greek organizations
 - Leadership development
 - Recruitment workshops
 - ***Standards of Excellence*** training
 - Risk Management and new member programs (partnering with Order of Omega)
 - Provide support for Greek Life programming
- Other tasks as assigned

EXPECTATIONS

- Participate in all trainings and retreats
- Attend regularly scheduled meetings
- Organize and facilitate at least two programs per semester
- Minimum one year term required
- Disaffiliating for all Ambassador events
- Maintain a positive attitude toward the overall Greek community
- Possess a desire to learn, grow, benefit from, and teach others about the Greek experience
- Provide servant leadership to the Greek community

QUALIFICATIONS

- Positive view and outlook on Greek membership in word and in deed
- Organization skills
- Leadership and facilitation experience
- Minimum requirement of Greek membership – must be fully initiated for one full semester
- A 2.5 cumulative and semester GPA is required
- In good standing with both the university and Greek organization – President's signature required
